

The FIRO-model


Fundamental Interpersonal Relations Orientation





The FIRO model


- This is a simplified model that works quite well as a theory on refereeing










Phase 3, Openness





- "Putting the house in order"






What kind of leadership is needed?

- Correcting behaviour




Prove that you still know how to referee floorball

- The leader and the group works together




What kind of leadership is needed?
